

2016 Attendance Rankings Place DPAC Among America's Top Theaters

Almost 500,000 Guests Enjoyed DPAC Performances This Year

DURHAM, NC- January 10, 2017 – After setting attendance records in 2016, **DPAC** is once again ranked among the top theaters in America, according to three leading national magazines that cover live U.S. entertainment events and venues.

In their year-end published attendance and sales rankings, *Pollstar*, *Billboard* and *Venues Today* all placed **DPAC** among the country's top five venues among reporting venues of its size and type. **DPAC**'s 2016 calendar year featured 235 events which drew a record-setting 490,883 guests and 108 sellouts. 2016 represents DPAC's eighth year of operation under the direction of **Nederlander** and **Professional Facilities Management (PFM)**.

DPAC ranked 5th in *Pollstar*, 4th in *Billboard*, and 3rd in *Venues Today*.

Broadway Leads the Way

Heading the list of the highest attended shows in 2016 were encore presentations of Disney's *The Lion King,* which entertained sellout crowds every night during its multi-week run in February and March, and the *Book of Mormon*. Both were part of DPAC's signature series, SunTrust Broadway at DPAC. **Dr. Seuss' How the Grinch Stole Christmas! The Musical** helped fill guests with the holiday spirit – and collaborated with the Autism Society of North Carolina and Duke Health to offer DPAC's first-ever special sensory-friendly performance.

"DPAC is the home of the biggest Broadway blockbusters. Fans of live theater know they can count on us to bring the newest hit shows direct from Broadway before they play any other theaters in the region," said Rachel Traversari, DPAC's Senior Director of Marketing. "Our team in New York is already lining up commitments for the biggest new shows that will fill our stage for years to come."

In addition to Broadway blockbusters, DPAC again delivered an incredible variety of events that truly offered 'something for everyone'. The legendary Queen of Soul Aretha Franklin led DPAC's concert sellouts, followed by pop veterans Duran Duran, blues singer Joe Bonamassa, and Nobel Peace Prize winner Bob Dylan. Comedy also played a big role in DPAC's year with Jeff Foxworthy & the Cable Guy, Ron White and Lewis Black each drawing large crowds to their multiperformance engagements. Special events included Food Network star Alton Brown's "Alton Brown Live: Eat Your Science," and a special run of Love Jones – The Musical, a musical stage adaptation of the renowned 1997 film.

"As much as our fans love Broadway, DPAC is equally known for the many concert and comedy events that come here every year," said Taki Pappas, Director of Programming for Concerts and Comedy at DPAC. "We work with the biggest talent agents and concert promoters in the world to bring incredible musicians and performers to DPAC so we can provide our guests with amazing concert and comedy experiences."
