"A Thriller of a Season" to Feature Blockbuster Shows including *MJ, Back to the Future: The Musical, Hamilton* & more!

GREENSBORO, N.C. – In partnership with Nederlander and Professional Facilities Management (PFM), the Steven Tanger Center for the Performing Arts announces the First Bank Broadway, 2024-25 Season at Tanger Center.
